KNIGHTS OF ST COLUMBA NATIONAL EASTER SEASON PAINTING COMPETITION JUNIORS GRADES. 2022

The Junior Easter Season Painting Competition is launched in September 2021. Provincial winning entries are to arrive at Head Office no later than **Friday 6th May 2022**

The competition is open to young people:

England/Wales School Year Groups: 3, 4, 5 & 6. (7 to 11 years of age)

Scotland School Year Groups; P4, P6 & P7 (7 to 11 years of age).

Note: The School Year Groupings will be the prime categorisation factor.

THEME GUIDE

1) The entries should depict a scene of the entrant's choice of an incident recalled from Palm Sunday and through the Easter Season.

2) Write Bible chapter and Verse that best relates to your drawing

The competitors' entries will be their own free hand and colouring productions; the use of pre-prepared tracings is to be discouraged. The entries should be submitted sized A4 or A3, on paper or card of a quality and colour of the entrant's choice. **The Bible Chapter and Verse can be written on the painting, on the reverse or on attachment.**

The following detail should be shown LEGIBLY in full on the reverse of the entry: THIS IS A MOST IMPORTANT ASPECT.

Name of entrant.

Age of entrant.

Date of Birth of entrant.

School Year Group.

Name and full address of the School/ Parish/ Group attended. The latter could be any recognised youth group.

Sponsoring Province and Council.

Entries will, in the first instance, be judged at local Council level, winning entries forwarded to Province for judging at Provincial level. ONLY the 1st, 2nd & 3rd placed age group winners from each Province is to be forwarded to Head Office for entry into the final National round of judging.

Councils and Provinces are advised to set their programmes to ensure that all entries from competing Councils are entered for Provincial adjudication, and that winning Provincial entries are forwarded to Head Office to arrive no later than Friday 6th May 2022 for final adjudication.

Final results will be announced in the Head Office Bulletin and awards presented locally .

The awards after final adjudication will be:

- Winner 1st Place: Cash Prize of 30:00.
 Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight.
 Winners Trophy to keep.
- 2nd Place: Cash Prize of £20:00.
 Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight.
- 3rd Place: Cash Prize of £15:00.
 Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight.

A cash award of £200:00 will be presented to the school or group of which the winner is a pupil or member.

Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight will also be presented to the winners school or group
