KNIGHTS OF St COLUMBA NATIONAL EASTER SEASON PAINTING COMPETITION SECONDARY AND SENIOR GRADES 2022.

The 2021 National Easter Season Painting Competition for Secondary and Senior Grade students is launched in September of 2021. Provincial winning entries are to arrive at Head Office no later than **Friday 6th May 2022**

The competition will again be open to two **separate age groups, i.e.**
England/Wales School Year Groups: 7, 8 & 9, (say 11 to 14 years of age).
Scotland School Year Groups: S1, S2 & S3, (say 11 to 14 years of age).

England/Wales School Year Groups: 10, 11, 12 & 13, (say 14 to 18 years of age).
Scotland School Year Groups: S4, S5 & S6, (say 14 to 18 years of age).

Note: The School Year Groupings will be the prime categorisation factor.

THEME GUIDE

- 1) The entries should depict a scene of the entrant's choice of an incident recalled during the period from the start of the Easter Triduum, (Feast of the Lord's Supper), to the Feast of Pentecost. **Do remember that the choice of scene depiction is quite varied and rarely recognised. In addition to the important and popular ones of the Last Supper, those recalling Christ's Passion on the first Good Friday and the Resurrection, there are the Journey to Emmaus, Appearances in the Upper Room and on the Shore of the Sea of Galilee, the Ascension, and Descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles. Each tell a significant story!**
- 2) **Write Bible chapter and Verse that best relates to your drawing**

The competitors' entries will be their own free hand drawing and colouring productions. Use of pre-prepared tracings should not be encouraged.

Entries are to be submitted, sized **A4 or A3**, on paper or card of quality and colour of the entrants' choice. **The Bible Chapter and Verse can be written on the painting, on the reverse or on attachment.**

The following detail should be shown legibly in full on the reverse of each entry: THIS ASPECT IS MOST IMPORTANT!.

Name of entrant.

Age of entrant.

D.O.B. of entrant.

School Year Group.

Name and full address of School/ Parish/ Group attended.

Sponsoring Province and /or Council.

Entries will, in the first instance, be judged at local Council level, winning entries forwarded to Province for judging at Provincial level. ONLY the 1st, 2nd & 3rd placed age group winners from each Province is to be forwarded to Head Office for entry into the final National round of judging.

Councils and Provinces are advised to set their programmes to ensure that all entries from competing Councils are entered for Provincial adjudication, and that winning Provincial entries are forwarded to Head Office to arrive no later than Friday 6th May 2022 for final adjudication. Final results will be announced in the Head Office Bulletin and awards presented locally . Awards, after final adjudication will be:

England/Wales School Year Groups: 7, 8 & 9, (say 11 to 14 years of age).

Scotland School Year Groups: S1, S2 & S3, (say 11 to 14 years of age).

Winner Group 1:	Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight. Cash Prize of £75:00. Winners Trophy to keep.
Runner Up in Groups 1.	Will receive: Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight. Cash Prize of £50:00.
Third Placed in Groups 1:	Each will receive: Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight. Cash Prize of £25:00.

A donation of £200 will be presented to the school or group of which the winners are members. Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight will also be presented to the winners school or group

England/Wales School Year Groups: 10, 11, 12 & 13, (say 14 to 18 years of age).

Scotland School Year Groups: S4, S5 & S6, (say 14 to 18 years of age).

Winner Group 2:	Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight. Cash Prize of £75:00. Winners Trophy to keep.
Runners Up in Groups 2.	Will receive: Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight. Cash Prize of £50:00
Third Placed in Groups 2:	Each will receive: Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight. Cash Prize of £25:00.

**A donation of £200 will be presented to the school or group of which the winners are members.
Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight will also be presented to the winners school or group**

Note: The overall winner will be the better winning entry of Group 1 and 2 combined.

Overall Winner Trophy which will be retained for approximately one Year by the Overall Winners Province or Group

Overall Winner Engraved Trophy to be held by the Winners Province for approximately one year.
